






Operating Revenue





Our Mission

The mission of Tower Grove Park is to be wooded Victorian park of international significance that provides important recreational, educational and cultural opportunities for the public in a way that is compatible with its unique and historic character.

Community & Cultural Impact

- Approximately 2.5 million annual visitors
- Three playgrounds, nine concrete and three grass tennis courts, seven miles of running/ walking trails, twelve softball/kickball fields, six soccer fields, three baseball fields, and other open green spaces for sports and recreation
- Twelve historic pavilions and four picnic sites for affordable gatherings and events
- Free Muckerman fountain and splash pad welcome thousands for cool relief each summer
- Free concerts from the St. Louis Symphony and Compton Heights Community Band, and the Summer Children's Concert Series offer music throughout the year for local audiences

Environmental Impact

- There are about 7,000 trees in Tower Grove Park, consisting of approximately 200 tree types
- The estimated value of Tower Grove Park's tree population is about \$10.2 million
- ullet The Park's trees provide about \$395,000 in annual environmental, economic, and social benefits
- The Gaddy Wild Bird Garden is designated as an Important Bird Area by the National Audubon Society, providing habitat for more than 200 recorded resident and migrating bird species
- Native plantings in new savannah areas and 14,000 recent plantings in riparian waterway corridors provide habitat and sustenance for Monarch butterflies and pollinators
